

TENTATIVE 2026-27 TRANSPORTATION



School District Routes:

Under Wisconsin state law, if a parent chooses a religious school, their public school district must transport the student(s) to the religious school free of charge (or pay a contract fee to parents) if the religious school is within the public school district or live miles from its district boundary. The family generally must live more than two miles away from the religious school to qualify for Transportation. To be placed on the rider list, parents should contact their district of residence:

Chartered Routes:

Aquinas Catholic Schools will continue its cooperative agreement with Luther High School to serve students who do not have access to public school transportation. This agreement gives students of our Catholic and Lutheran High Schools access to the chartered bus routes of both schools, greatly expanding our transportation network and making Catholic high school more accessible to families in surrounding communities. Limited bus service is available to ACS elementary schools for families who do not have access to a Catholic school in a local parish.


To add your name to the rider list for one of these chartered routes, please contact Go Riteway at 608-881-6370. Go Riteway will be able to answer any questions and give more details on pickup locations and schedules as the rider is initialized.

School Calendars:

Chartered routes will operate on days when ACS and/or Luther High School are scheduled to be in session. If one school is scheduled to be closed and the other is scheduled to be in session, chartered routes will still run for students of the school that is in session. However, if no student from that school regularly rides a particular route, Go Riteway may choose to not offer that route on those days.

School district routes will continue to run on days that ACS is scheduled to hold classes, but the public school district is scheduled to be closed. Bus service for long holiday periods (i.e. Spring Break) may be adjusted based on ridership levels and interest.

Tentative Aquinas/Luther High School Bus Transportation: 2026-2027

In an effort to reduce bus transportation costs the Board of Control adopted the policy that the Luther High School buses follow the most direct and convenient routes with designated pick-up points. It is, therefore, often necessary for students to come a short distance to meet the bus. Any requests for a bus to deviate from the route may be made to the Board of Control.

Please note that these routes are subject to change at the discretion of Luther High School.

These times are general reference points. PM ridership is rather varied which can have a greater impact on times. As the school year progresses, you should see more consistent pick-up times for your child.

TENTATIVE Bus Transportation Registration Information: 2026-2027 Aquinis, Providence, Immanuel, St. Paul's Families

Luther High School provides bus transportation to and from school via four chartered buses through Go-Riteway. These four routes are listed below.

Registration for this transportation is now open. Please keep in mind that:

- You may be able to secure transportation via your local school district. Check that option first.
- Luther's four routes are not intended to be door to door pick-ups. There are established pick-up points for families to meet the bus.
- Here Comes the Bus app should be fully operational on all four of our routes.
- These four routes end at Luther High School. From there, students would transfer to a shuttle which completes your trip to the appropriate school.
- Schedules may vary and will be communicated to you through your school system's communication network.

Luther High School Chartered Bus

Luther High School contracts four buses to transport students from outlying areas.

- 1) *Tomah, Sparta, Bangor, West Salem => Luther ->shuttle to Providence/Imm schools*
- 2) *(Genoa), Stoddard, La Crosse Central => Luther ->shuttle to Providence/Imm schools*
- 3) *Lewiston, Ridgeway, Nodine, La Crescent => Luther ->shuttle to Providence/Imm schools*
- 4) *Winona, Galesville, Holmen, Onalaska => Luther ->shuttle to Providence/Imm schools*
