### Kwik Trip Car Wash Fundraiser= Sept.23-Oct 7

The Kwik Trip Car Wash Card Fundraiser sale continues through Thursday, October 7. A reminder that this is the one major fundraiser for the school year. I ask that all families participate in order to make this fundraiser a success. If you misplaced your flyer with the details for this fundraiser the form is available on the front page of your website or feel free to contact our school office for a hard copy.

We have a school goal of selling 500 cards = 5 cards per family. If a family would prefer to not sell the 5 cards and donate \$80 (5 cards at \$16 profit per card), which is the profit we make from a set of 5 sold cards, that is an option as well. Families who have children at both Cathedral and Blessed Sacrament Schools are asked to sell only 5 cards per family as well. You may turn in your order form any time during the sale and at either school. Mrs. Moll and I have a plan for splitting the profit from the sales so there is nothing on the family end that needs to be figured out or done.

While students are not necessarily selling the cards, they are good at reminding and helping parents to do so. I will explain to the students that there is a school prize - a mystery assembly on October 15 - if we reach our school goal. I thank you in advance for your participation and support.

The money raised stays at each school and each school will be using the monies raised for school projects and needs. At Cathedral School we have several projects - a new kitchen stove/oven unit, updates to our bell and clock system, and continued upgrades to our classroom ceiling tiles - that we are reviewing with cost and profit options for the 2021-22 funds earned.
